Second: Training implementation procedures

All administrative and technical procedures that have been implemented and are still being implemented until the completion of the training are presented as follows:

- 1- Efforts made by Prof. Magdy Rady, the university's external relations advisor, to obtain approval to start implementing the training at October 6 University.
- 2- It was announced that the registration of trainees will start on 3/23/2022
- 3- Two workshops were conducted for the training trainers to explain how to prepare the training packages required to be prepared before the start of the training
- 4- The start of the implementation of the training was announced on 4/23/2022 and the training plan, which included specifying the days of direct training, distance training, and the number of study weeks, which amounted to 7 weeks for ten training courses.
- 5- Several appropriate learning strategies and methods were used for training
- 6- The number of beneficiaries of the training reached (70) trainees from (Syria-Egypt-Eritrea-Sudan-Yemen).
- 7- The trainees were divided into two groups so that they are trained in parallel and within the same time period of the training plan
- 8- It was indicated that October 6 University obtained the approval of the Supreme Council of Private and Private Universities to start implementing the teaching

(professional diploma for refugee teachers) starting from the academic year 2022/2023 at a rate of 20 students annually

The legislative authorities, which are the Supreme Council of Universities, prevent the enrolment in studies with a professional diploma, in order to prepare refugee teachers as educationally unqualified individuals, which hinders the desire of many refugees to enrol in a diploma.
